## **GUIDELINES FOR VISITATION**

- 1. Visitation will occur in designated areas outside in the courtyards between C & D in Step 2 of the re-opening plan. In the case of inclement weather, visits will occur indoors in the family room.
- 2. The spaces for visiting will be either in the courtyards between C & D wing or the family room. There are 8 spaces in the C wing courtyard and 10 in the D wing courtyard.
- 3. Tables will be used to ensure 6 feet between residents and visitors.
- 4. Visits will occur from 9-1130 am M-F and 1-4pm M-F (last visit starts at 4 pm). If extenuating circumstances exist, visits can be scheduled at a mutually agreeable time on Sat or M-F evening.
- 5. Each unit will be a assigned a day of the week for visits. Visit times will be scheduled on the hour and be 30 minutes in length. Visits can be split into 2-15 minute intervals to accommodate up to 4 visitors.
- 6. SS will coordinate the scheduling of visitors.
- 7. Residents will wear surgical masks for visits. Visitors will wear respirator masks provided by the facility.
- 8. A Life Enrichment staff member and a volunteer will supervise the visits. The LE staff member and security guard can temperature screen and assist visitors to sign in. The switchboard operator can also temperature screen and sign in visitors. The volunteer cannot assist with the temperature screening.
- 9. Life Enrichment Staff, Nursing Staff, and volunteers will assist with the transport of residents to the designated visiting areas and return to the nursing units.
- 10. Hand hygiene will be performed by residents and visitors before and after visits.
- 11. Visitors will review and sign education on the visiting guidelines prior to the start of the visit.
- 12. After the visit concludes, EVS will sanitize the areas between visits. If EVS is unable to sanitize the area, Life Enrichment Staff will clean the area.
- 13. Families/Responsible Parties will be offered either a face to face visit or a virtual visit based on facility availability.
