

GUIDANCE FOR VISITING RESIDENTS AT CEDARBROOK SENIOR CARE & REHAB
Green Rooms Only – Lehigh County Positivity Rate of 0% to 5%

1. All Visitors MUST:

- Schedule their visit ahead of time with SS.
- Arrive 10 minutes early to be screened; remain in car if arriving earlier.
- Enter through the main entrance at CBFH and the D wing visitor entrance at CBA for all visits.
- Always wear a mask/face covering as provided by the facility both indoors and outdoors. Please note that Skilled Nursing Regulations still require visitors to wear masks during visits to the nursing home regardless of vaccination status.
- Maintaining six feet social distance is highly preferred.
- Use hand sanitizer before and after visitation.
- Be 12 years or older.
- Stay in designated visitation areas only.
- Refrain from discussing private health information (PHI) during the visit.
- Diet appropriate food/beverage (snacks) can be brought to the visit to be enjoyed **AFTER** the visit is completed. They may be given to the LE staff at the start of the visit. No homemade food/beverage is permitted.
- Stay within the 45-minute visit time allotment.
- Stay home if you have signs and symptoms of respiratory illness, Fever or Chills, Cough, Shortness of Breath, Fatigue, Muscle or Body Aches, Headache, Congestion or runny nose, Nausea or Vomiting, Diarrhea, Sore Throat, Loss of taste/smell. Access will be denied if any of these conditions exist. As a friendly reminder, our screening process also precludes those with active covid-19 diagnoses or recent covid-19 exposures (14 days) from entering our facility in alignment with public health directives.

2. Visiting hours and rules:

- M-F 9:15 am- 1100 am and 1:00 pm- 4:45 pm.
- Visitation will be limited to 45 minutes. 2 visitors/resident for 45 minutes or 2 visitors/resident for 20 minutes each (4 visitors total).
- Residents will be offered Face to face visit or virtual visit as schedule allows.
- All visits are staff monitored for compliance to rules.
- Pets may accompany visitors for OUTDOOR visits only. Pets must be registered as per facility policy.
- Non – compliance will result in termination of the visit.

3. Scheduling Visits:

- To schedule a visit, contact the resident's Social Worker.

- Please note when scheduling you will need to complete or provide contact information such including address, phone number, email and resident name for contact tracing purposes if needed in the future.
- To cancel an appointment please call the resident's Social Worker at least 24 hours in advance if possible. When SS is not in the office, please notify the Nursing Supervisor on duty of the cancellation.

4. Screening upon arrival:

- Go directly to **the Security** entrance 10 minutes before your scheduled time (do not go in the Main Dining Room at CBFH or the Family Room/visiting area at CBA until you are screened). Please use the main entrance if inclement weather.
- You will have your temperature taken and will need to complete a COVID visitor screening form. Education and consent forms will also be provided.

5. Additional information:

- At this time outdoors will be the preferred setting and arrangements have been made to accommodate this safely.
- Indoor visitation will be allowed in specified dining rooms or lounges, but not directly in the resident rooms, except for end-of-life visits.
- Visitation areas will be disinfected after each use.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in the visitation areas.
- Visitation guidelines exist to attempt to maintain responsible social distancing measures.
- Overall Visitation is restricted for unvaccinated residents if the Lehigh County positivity rate is greater than 10% and less than 70% of residents are vaccinated, or for all residents if the facility is experiencing a facility-wide Covid-19 positive outbreak.
- Visitation for a specific unit is canceled if the unit moves into a "Yellow" status indicating a recent possible exposure.
- Visitation guidance may be updated at any time based on the county positivity rate. Visitation can be terminated at any time by state or federal epidemiological or regulatory directive.
